

**FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORKSHOP MEETING
December 16, 2010**

CALL TO ORDER

Present were Supervisors Donald Lerew, John Shambaugh, and Edward Campbell. Also present was Secretary Nancy Zentmeyer. The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. at the Township Municipal Building, 150 Century Lane, Dillsburg, York County, PA.

ADOPTION OF 2011 BUDGET

Motion: Supervisor Campbell made a motion to adopt the township budget for 2011 as advertised. **Seconded** by Vice Chairman Shambaugh. The motion carried.

CONDITIONAL USE HEARING – SET DATE

It was noted that an application has been received for a conditional use hearing from Mr. Jacob Bosley for an accessory structure which is over 1,000 s.f. After a brief discussion it was decided to schedule the hearing for January 13, 2011 beginning at 6:30 p.m. prior to the continuation hearing of the Brookshire MHP.

MIKE WHITZEL – FRANKLINTOWN FIRE COMPANY

Chief Whitzel informed the Supervisors of the radio issues they are having with the 911 Center, especially after the incident on Route 15 last night. It seems that the patch locked up and the emergency services and fire company could not communicate. If they use the Adams County patch #2 then they cannot communicate with Cumberland County. It was suggested to send a letter to 911 stating that the Board of Supervisors are aware of this problem and it is to be remedied as soon as possible and that the Township expects 911 to send the township a letter of this problem being remedied.

INVOICE FOR EMA SUPPLIES

After reviewing the invoice from Precision Sign for supplies the Supervisors indicated that they need an explanation of what is being ordered.

ROAD ICING

Vice Chairman Shambaugh indicated that there is a problem with icing on Franklin Church Road near the intersection of Meadowview Drive. Representative Perry needs to be made aware of this problem.
