PennDOT to Enact New Traffic Restrictions on Golf Course Road and Range Road at U.S. 15 in Carroll Township, York County

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) will enact traffic restrictions prohibiting left turns and cross traffic from Golf Course Road and Range Road onto U.S. 15 south of Dillsburg Borough in Carroll Township, York County. The new traffic restrictions will take effect Tuesday, August 13.

Temporary curbing, reflective delineators and related signing will be installed to help implement the new restrictions. These restrictions only affect those traveling on Golf Course Road or Range Road who want to turn left onto, or crossover U.S. 15. There will be no traffic operations changes for U.S. 15 travelers.

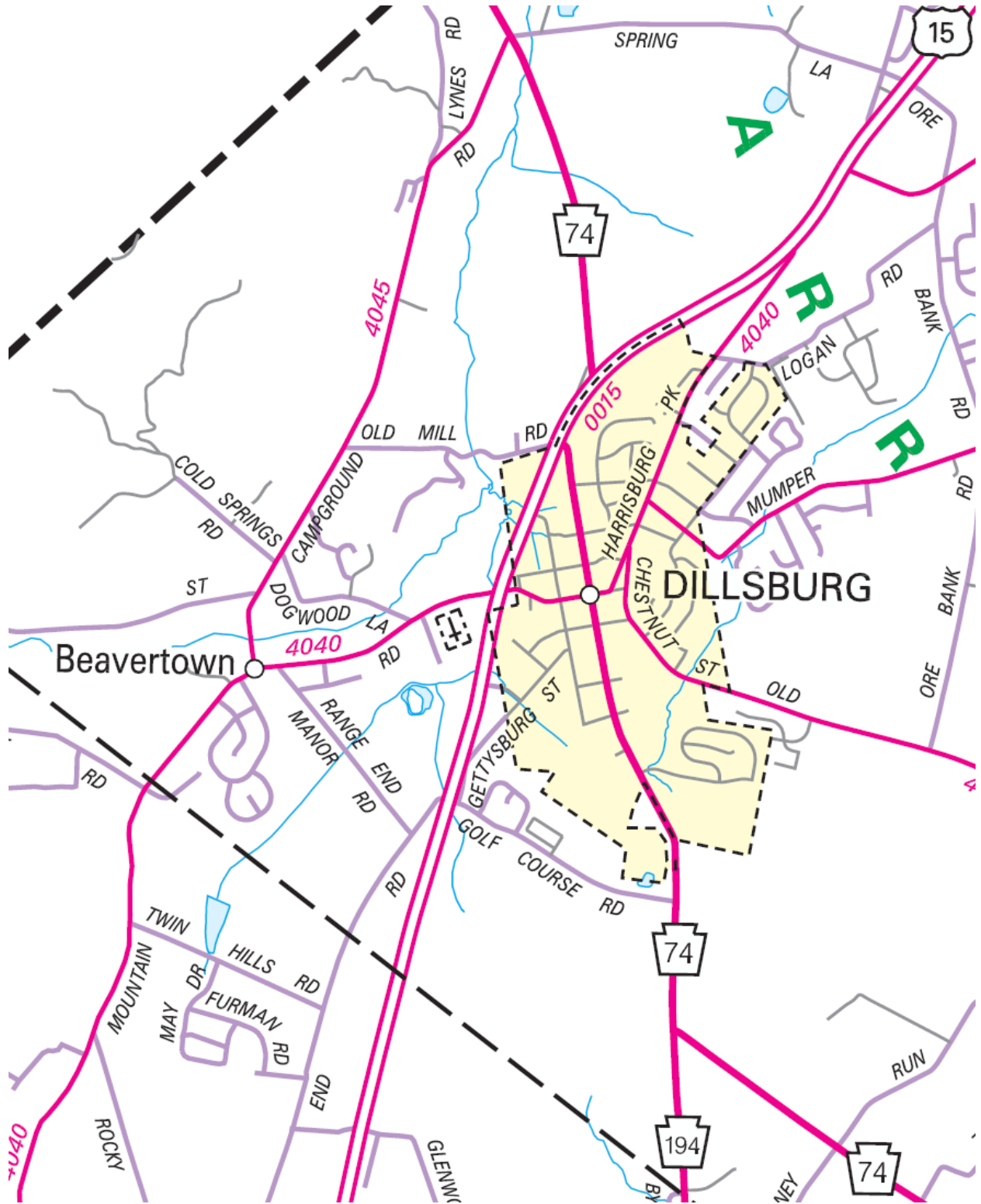
