Course Guidelines and Requirements

- Must be 16 years old to participate (Minors must be accompanied by Parent/Guardian)
- All CERT graduates receive a certificate and a York County CERT backpack full of emergency essentials
- The team member course is 20-24 hours
- CERT participants get hands-on experience through simulated disasters
- Closed Toe Shoes, Long Sleeve Shirt and Pants Required for hands on operations
