

EXTENSION THROUGH NOVEMBER 11, 2020, OF  
DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on Monday, March 23, 2020, the Supervisors of Franklin Township declared a disaster emergency in response to the public health emergency arising from the coronavirus (COVID-19);


WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Franklin Township subsequently extended the declaration of disaster emergency through April 30, 2020, May 13, 2020, June 10, 2020, July 8, 2020, August 12, 2020, September 9, 2020, and then October 14, 2020; and


WHEREAS, COVID-19 will continue to pose a threat to the health and safety of residents of Franklin Township even as certain restrictions have been and continue to be lifted;

NOW, THEREFORE, we the Supervisors of Franklin Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7501, as amended, do hereby extend our March 23, 2020 declaration of disaster emergency through November 11, 2020.


This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.






