

EXTENSION THROUGH APRIL 30, 2020 OF
DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on Monday, March 23, 2020, the Supervisors of Franklin Township declared a disaster emergency in response to the public health emergency arising from the coronavirus (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, on Friday, March 27, 2020, the Governor and Secretary of Health of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania revised their “Stay at Home” orders to include York County; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, March 29, 2020, the President of the United States extended nationwide social distancing guidelines through April 30, 2020:

NOW, THEREFORE, we the Supervisors of Franklin Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7501, as amended, do hereby extend our March 23, 2020 declaration of disaster emergency through April 30, 2020.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.
