

EXTENSION THROUGH MAY 13, 2020 OF
DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on Monday, March 23, 2020, the Supervisors of Franklin Township declared a disaster emergency in response to the public health emergency arising from the coronavirus (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Franklin Township subsequently extended the declaration of disaster emergency through April 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, on Friday, March 27, 2020, the Governor and Secretary of Health of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania revised their “Stay at Home” orders to include York County;

WHEREAS, the statewide “Stay at Home” order is effective through May 8, 2020, at which time a phased reopening will begin in certain parts of the Commonwealth yet to be specified; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 will continue to pose a threat to the health and safety of residents of Franklin Township even as certain restrictions are lifted;

NOW, THEREFORE, we the Supervisors of Franklin Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7501, as amended, do hereby extend our March 23, 2020 declaration of disaster emergency through May 13, 2020.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.
