**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-1**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
FRANKLIN, ORDINANCE NO. 2-2001, TO MODIFY ARTICLE NUMBERING AND  
CLARIFY THAT PARKING ON CERTAIN ROADS SHALL BE PROHIBITED  
DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER TO FACILITATE SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors in and for the Township of Franklin, York County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: The heading following the text of Article II, Section 10—Authority of Police Officers in Ordinance No. 2-2001, Traffic Ordinance of the Township of Franklin, which currently reads “Article II,” is hereby amended to correctly read “Article III.”

SECTION 2: Article IV—Parking Regulations, Section 1.A, of Ordinance No. 2-2001, Traffic Ordinance of the Township of Franklin, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

A. To facilitate snow and ice removal, parking shall be prohibited on the below indicated Township roads and highways during inclement weather during both of the following periods of each year:

- (1) January 1<sup>st</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup>; and
- (2) November 15<sup>th</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>.

SECTION 3: The heading “Article VI,” which follows the text of Article IV, Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2-2001, Traffic Ordinance of the Township of Franklin, is hereby amended to correctly read “Article V.”

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after adoption, consistent with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.
