

**RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE
PER CAPITA TAX RELIEF**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township to provide relief for delinquent payment of the local per capita tax as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHEREAS, Franklin Township has already acted by resolution under Act 15 of 2020 to provide that no fee or penalty associated with the late payment of the tax imposed on the assessed value of real estate shall be imposed, provided that such tax is paid in its entirety by December 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, Franklin Township has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township, its residents and taxpayers for the Township to provide relief with regard to local per capita taxes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Tax Enabling Act, and such other law which may apply, Franklin Township is authorized to prescribe reasonable penalties for delinquent payments of per capita taxes;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic continues to have an extraordinary economic impact on the residents of Franklin Township;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Franklin Township hereby waives any fees or penalties associated with the late payment of its per capita tax, provided that the tax is paid in its entirety by December 31, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of Franklin Township deliver a copy of this resolution to the Township's tax collector immediately.


